Recreational Pilot Permit – Aeroplane

Pre-Requisites:

There is no requirement regarding education other than that you must be able to read and write one of Canada's official languages. However, being a University graduate or at least have finished high school is a big plus.

Minimum age: 16 years

Transport Canada category 1, 3 or 4 medical certificate

You can start your training @ 14 years old and go solo.

Requirements:

25 hours flight time, of which at least:

15 hours must be with an instructor (dual)

2 hours must be cross country experience

5 hours must be as pilot in command (solo)

Minimum RPP course cost:

20 hrs dual @ \$180/hr:	\$3,600.00
20 hrs instructor @ \$70/hr:	\$1,400.00
5 hrs solo @ \$180/hr:	\$900.00

Total:	\$6,400.00*

All rates are wet (include fuel/oil costs) but do not include GST.

*This is the minimum cost for a Recreational Pilot Permit. It is very unlikely to complete the course in the minimum time. In our experience, the average student without previous flying experience will take approximately 35-40 hours. Therefore a more *realistic* cost would be between **\$7,500.00 and \$8,800.00**

Courses may be paid:

- as you go
- by a deposit of a given amount
- by a deposit of total amount

Refund Policy: A full refund will be given for unused deposits if the student withdraws from the course.

Privileges: This permit allows you to fly as pilot for pleasure in an aircraft with four (or less) seats, carrying no more than one passenger, while in Canadian airspace, during the day only. You are not able to add any ratings to it.
